Must-Have Supplies:

Requested Supplies:

- 1 ream of colored copy paper or 1 ream of white (or colored) cardstock
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 class set of shelf-stable snack items (granola bars, goldfish, crackers, etc. enough for 28 students)
