One suggestion that could dramatically improve the safe crossing zones near the school would be to request the crossing guard located at the corner of Old Post and Shadow Valley drive be moved to the crosswalk near the school, East of the lower parking lot. I turn at this intersection every morning between 8:40-8:45 am and have yet to see him cross a student, not once (in fact I witnessed an adult crossing here this morning and he did not use the cross walk or the crossing guard). The crossing guard seems bored and almost asleep at times, I am sure he would prefer to make more of an impact for our kids. With the reduction in number of bus stops available, it has been considerably more crowded and therefore, less safe.

In addition, where this crosswalk is located crosses people from a sidewalk to the side of the road with only grass and no sidewalk. I don't have any background here, but it seems that would be out of policy in itself to cross onto a non sidewalk area.

I believe this is an Ogden city decision, but if I am correct moving him from this location to the lower crosswalks nearer to the school would still be Ogden City property and streets. I have attached some images illustrating this option. *Please forgive my poor poor point skills.
