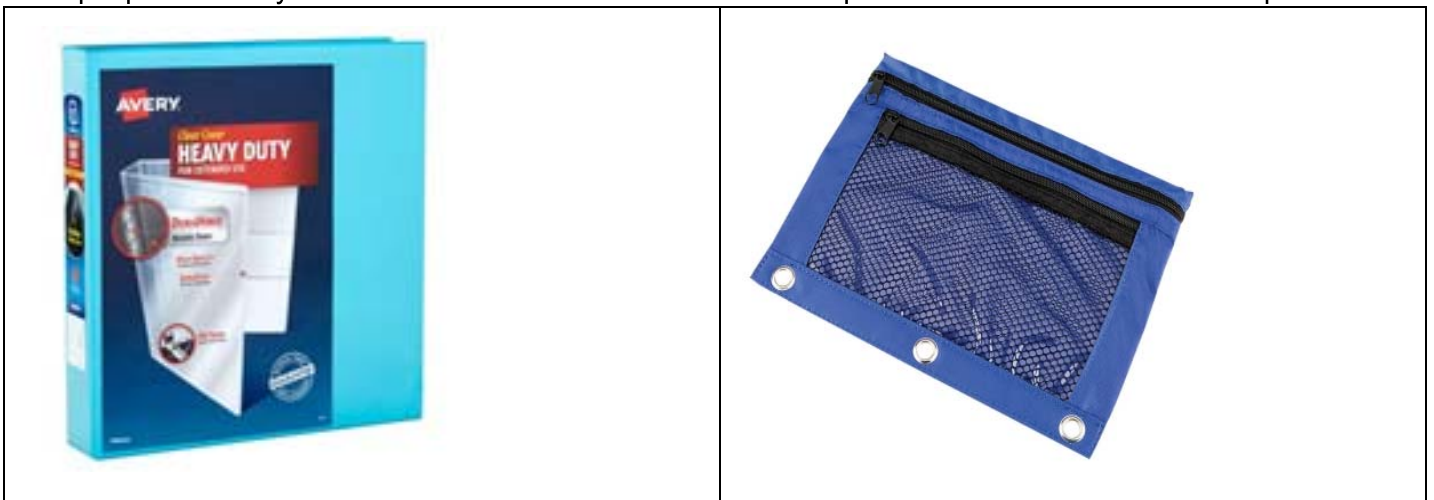
In fourth grade, we use AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) strategies. Each student will use a 2-inch binder for all subjects as their personal mobile desk. This binder will hold and organize their work, used for each subject, and will be brought home on a daily basis.

PLEASE: It is important to only donate what is listed below as this is critical for us to help foster the AVID culture in the classroom with our students. Also, please do not mark donations with the student's name.

We also welcome any of the items for other students if you are able to help. Remember, this is just a suggested supply list. The school will provide all materials regardless of whether students donate or not.

- A basic 2.0-inch binder with clear view cover. D-ring suggested but not required.
 - Please do not get larger or smaller than this size.
 - Please, no zippers or cloth binders.
 - Please make sure it has a clear view cover
- 3-ring pencil pocket (please no fancy or elaborate pencil pouches)
